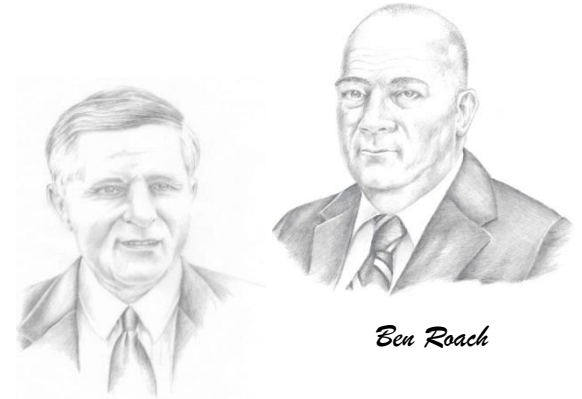

“Chronic Wasting Disease in Cervids – the Latest News in Pennsylvania”

Courtney Colley is the Communications Specialist with the Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC). She graduated from Penn State University with a B.S. degree in Earth and Mineral Sciences in 2013 and earned a Master of Environmental Science from Shippensburg University in 2015. She has taught wildlife diseases and Geographic Information Systems at Penn State in an adjunct position and worked for the Keystone Elk Country Alliance as a Conservation Education Coordinator. Courtney transferred to the PGC in July of 2018 to continue her education work with the public as the CWD Communications Specialist. Ms. Colley is recognized across Pennsylvania for her educational efforts to bring awareness to the public of the latest developments in CWD.

Ms. Colley’s presentation will be of interest to forest managers, foresters, biologists, hunters, loggers, and all recreationists using the forests. Deer are known as “keystone” species, meaning they can affect their environment. Any disease that affects deer will, in turn, affect the landscape over time.
